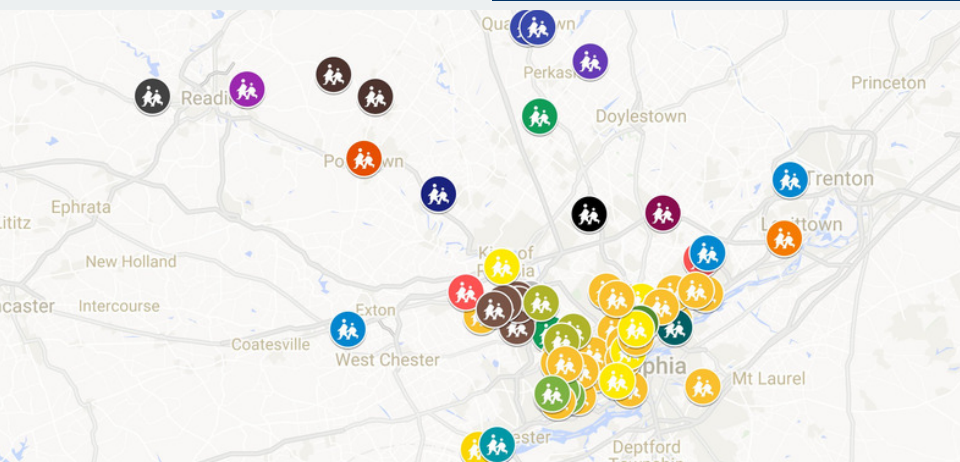

## THE PROGRAM

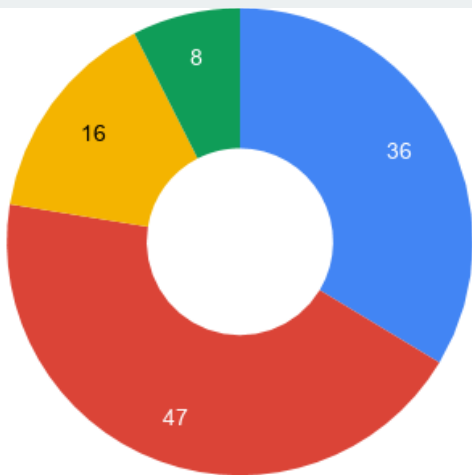

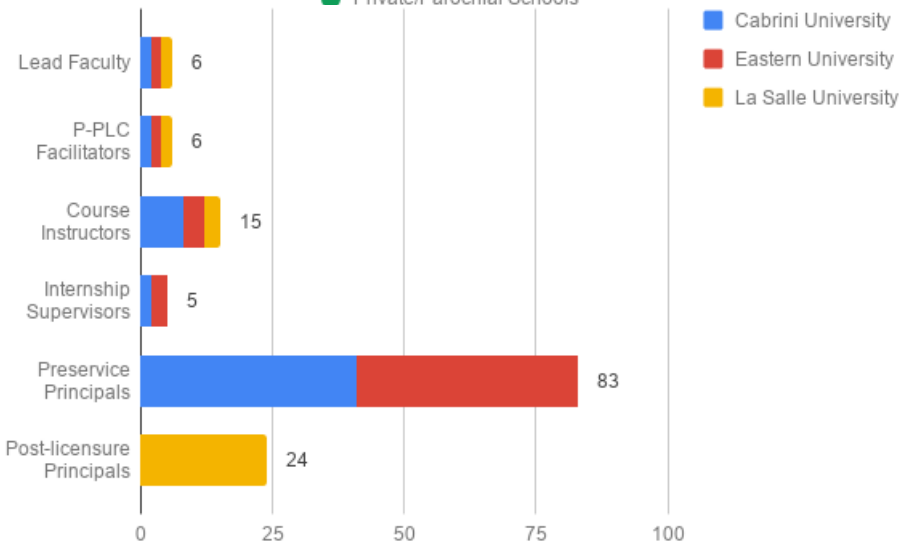
